PATHOGEN: Phoma apiicola

HOST: celery (Apium graveolens)

COMMON NAME: crown and root rot

METHOD: Lcb 2.1 Grow-out (Hewitt, 1971)

METHOD CLASS: TEMPORARY STANDARD (B)

SAMPLE: 1,000 seeds

PROCEDURE:

1. 1,000 seed samples are planted in a cool greenhouse for 6 weeks.

2. Seedling hypocotyls are examined for blackening and pycnidia.
